

****PRESS RELEASE****WALLA WALLA POLICE DEPT**** One Victim Hospitalized After Two Sunday Shootings

Detectives are investigating two separate shootings that occurred Sunday evening, the second one sending a 25-year-old gang affiliate to a hospital for treatment of 3 gunshot wounds.

The first report was called in at 5:33 p.m. of several shots being fired in the area of 4th Avenue and Chestnut Street. Witnesses gave conflicting information about a possible suspect vehicle, or if a vehicle was involved in the shooting. It appeared the target of the shooting is a multi-family rental located in the 200 block of West Chestnut. There were no injuries reported and no arrests have been made at this time.

The second shooting was reported at 11:43 p.m. in the alley south of the 200 block of Eagan St. The victim—Salvador Duran Saucedo, was walking in the alley when a vehicle pulled up and began firing at him. He was transported by ambulance to a hospital for treatment of his injuries and is currently in stable condition.

Saucedo, who is a known gang affiliate and has been arrested by local law enforcement at least 12 times, refused to give a statement to law enforcement.

It is not known at this time if the shootings are related, although each occurred within a few blocks of the other during a 6-hour period.
